What advice would you give other scholarship holders coming to this host country?

Get heavy clothes, april was so tough ahahha suddenly it snowed and I was not prepared properly, try to make the most out of the experience even though it might be hard at first and you might want to go home, but remember that it will be worth it at the end of it, the growth and lessons learnt and the friendships will continue forever and you will be able to look back at this and be proud of yourself.
