

FAQs for Incomings' application form

- Arrival and departure dates:

Indicate your approximate arrival and departure date. They don't need to be definite yet. Please note, that you need to be present at DHBW Stuttgart for the first week of March (Summer semester) or for the first week of September (Winter semester) for the Welcome Week.

Accommodation:

Please state in this field (yes/no) if you want to apply for a student dormitory in Stuttgart.

The dorms are rented usually for the whole semester and shorter contracts are not possible. Indicate the length of your stay approximately starting from the beginning of the semester until an approximate day of departure.

In case you have other special requirements regarding accommodation, state them here. Please note, that this is not an application for the dorm! The accommodation process is done later together with the student services Studierendenwerk Stuttgart (SWS). Follow the instructions sent to you from the International Office.

It is really hard to find private accommodation in Stuttgart and almost 100% of the past exchange students have applied for a student dormitory.

- Insurance:

Read the text carefully and sign the statement. It is required by DHBW Stuttgart that you have a travelling health insurance for the time of leaving from your home country until the beginning of the semester in DHBW (1st March / 1st September). By signing the statement, you confirm that you have been informed, that for students outside the EU it is mandatory to take a German health insurance before you travel to Germany. The International Office will send out respective information and will support you setting it up.

- Data protection:

By checking the data protection box, you agree that we have a permission to process and store your personal data.

1. Signature Form:

Place means the city where you are in the moment when you sign the application form.

Sign the application yourself and ask for the signatures from your foreign coordinator and the head of the department. Please note, that you also need to have the form stamped by your home university

- 2. **Copy of Passport** is a scan of the information page of your passport (stating your name, birth date etc.)
- 3. **Passport-sized photo** should have a good quality. This picture is used for your student ID at DHBW Stuttgart. For those students who have to apply for residence permit in Stuttgart, a passport photo in paper is needed



- 4. **Proof of Language Proficiency (not for native speakers)** states that your English skill level is at least B2. Acceptable tests are: DAAD-language certificate or compatible (f. ex. TOEFL IBT 79, TOEFL PBT 550, TOEFL ITP 550, TOEIC 765, IELTS 6).
- 5. **Transcript of Records** is a transcript from your home university. It should state the courses and grades you have received at your home university so far.
- 6. **Financial Statement in EUR/ US\$** should state that you have sufficient financial means to support yourself during the exchange semester abroad. Please submit an official statement from the bank that shows your balance in English. A letter from a parent or a sponsor is not sufficient; it has to be from the bank.

Please note that a certain amount of money has to be on the account. A rule for this is that you need to have at least EUR 934 per month of stay on your account.

Duration of stay and amount for financial proof:

4 months: 4 x EUR 934 = EUR 3,736 5 months: 5 x EUR 934 = EUR 4,670 6 months: 6 x EUR 934 = EUR 5,604

Please note that **only** students from <u>outside the EU + UK</u> need to submit the proof of funding.

- 7. Course Choice is your choice of courses for your semester at DHBW Stuttgart. Please select of maximum of 30 ECTS. We recommend students to take between 20 and 30 ECTS per semester. You will receive this document from the International Office, it is also available in our download section. Erasmus + students should create an Online Learning Agreement (OLA).
- 8. **Reference letter** is an academic reference letter from a professor at your home university. It should describe your academic performance and personal suitability for the exchange programme at DHBW Stuttgart.
- 9. Proof of travel insurance needs to be taken before leaving your home country and it needs to cover you from the moment you leave until the beginning of the semester at DHBW Stuttgart (1st March / 1st September). Take the traveling insurance as soon as you know your travelling dates. This document can be sent later to DHBW but it needs to be sent before travelling.
